### COLONEL TREVOR O. D. NOEL

Colonel Trevor O. D. Noel's last assignment was as the Director of Staff-Air at the Joint Forces Headquarters Ohio Air National Guard Columbus Ohio. The Ohio Air National Guard comprises of 4 Flying Wings and 6 Geographically Separated Units, totaling over 4,700 members.

As the Director of Staff for the Ohio Air National Guard, he served as the principal advisor to the Adjutant General and the Assistant Adjutant General Air on a broad range of matters concerning the United States Air Force and Air National Guard. He served as the Ohio Air National Guard headquarter's fulltime chief of staff or chief executive officer, and was responsible for a wide range of functions including Joint Programs & Operations, Force Development, Performance Management, Logistics & Plans, Information Systems, Manpower and Personnel, Public Affairs, Recruiting and Retention, Civil Engineering, Medical and State Emergency Response.

He facilitated coordination with the Ohio Army National Guard senior leadership on joint programs and activities within the state. He manages a broad range of program responsibilities to include special Air National Guard programs or initiatives such as Diversity and Inclusion, Family Support, Employer Support, and State Partnership programs. He also oversaw the development, execution, and evaluation of programs and policies pertaining to the command, control, operation and management of the Ohio Air National Guard.

Colonel Noel was a voting member of the Ohio National Guard's Executive Board which is responsible for the Strategic leadership and direction of the 17,000 plus members.

Colonel Noel holds two Master of Science degrees, one in Strategic Studies and the other in Human Resource Management, and a Bachelor of Science in Geography. He was commissioned in December 1981 from Texas A&M University where he was a member of the Texas A&M Corps of Cadets. He completed Squadron Officer School in residence in 1989, Air Command and Staff College in seminar in 1998 and Air War College in residence in 2004.
